

Invitation to Bid

Sealed bids for the design of a hatchery pump house will be received by Lummi Indian Business Council Public Works Department at the reception desk located on the second floor of the LIBC Administration Building, 2665 Kwina Road, Bellingham, WA until 1:30 p.m. on March 20, 2017.

This contract provides for design of a 450 square foot facility to house six pumps.

The scope includes design and specification of structural, mechanical, electrical, interior and exterior features, finishes, equipment compatible with the levels and types of anticipated uses and other systems necessary to support the primary function. The scope includes preparation of final design and construction bid documents. This contract is subject to the Indian Preference Requirements set forth in Section 7(b) of the Indian Self-Determination and Education Assistance Act (25 USC 450e(b)).

The Lummi Indian Business Council reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to waive informalities in the bidding.
